TALK IT OVER

Start Talking

Have you ever felt overwhelmed, ill-prepared or unequipped to do something that you were being asked to do? Maybe it was a new job that you were stepping into or a new season of life that you were about to embark on. Talk about that experience.

Start Thinking

What is one part of the message that resonated with you? What's one thing you will take away from the message?

(v. 1-9)

- Daniel said that God doesn't call the qualified, but instead, qualifies the called. What do you think that means? {Look up 2nd Corinthians 2:15-17}
- God spent 40 years preparing Joshua for his calling. Ecclesiastes 3:1 says, '*For everything that happens in life there is a season and a right time for everything under heaven.*' What season of life do you feel like you are currently in right now? What season have you recently come out of? How is God calling you to be faithful where you are?
- God told Joshua that He was going to give the Israelites everywhere that they placed the soul of their feet. How is this a picture of activating our faith and what does it mean to walk by faith?
- Why is God's word so vital to our success in life? What are some the things (excuses) that keep us from spending more time studying God's word? What kind of plan can you come up with to make sure that you are consistently spending time with God in His word?
